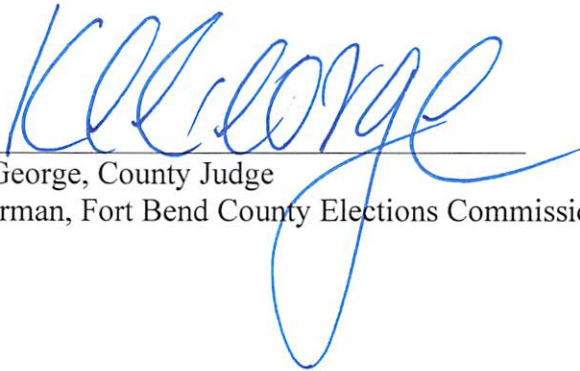

Policy of Non-Discrimination on the Basis of Disability
